NOTE: Remember to include a copy of your driver's license, a full regalia color photo, and the 500 word essay!

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Must identify as a female not younger than 19 years of age and not older than 25 years of age as of Sunday, September 22, 2019.
- Must have received a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Must be a member from a Treaty 7 Nation.
- Must include a copy of driver's license and Indian status card.
- Must be committed to the year long reign and promotion of the Elbow River Camp and Calgary Stampede.
- Have a valid passport.
- Must have her own reliable transportation for the duration of her reign.
- Must not have a criminal record and must consent to a security check.
- Competency in a Native language is an asset.
- Basic riding ability and skills is an asset.
- Must submit photo in full regalia in JPEG format.
- Must submit 2 personal references (family not eligible as reference).
- Applicants must be sponsored by a current Tipi Owner residing within the Elbow River Camp at the Calgary Stampede.

NOTE: Mandatory attendance will be required at the Calgary Stampede First Nations Princess Crowning Orientation:

Saturday, September 7, 2019 • 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. at Stampede Park- Headquarters Building

Contestants will receive telephone and email confirmation of eligibility during the week of September 4, 2019.

JUDGING

You will be judged by representatives of the Calgary Stampede, members of the Calgary community and representatives of Treaty 7. Contestants will be judged on the following:

- Application package
- Personal interview
- Five minute publicspeaking presentation
- Dance
- Interpersonal communication
